Study Purpose

The Danforth Study will bring together the following elements through a comprehensive and coordinated planning and public engagement process:

- A **complete street study**, to examination of the roadway width and curbside uses (i.e. parking and loading/unloading) and review options for a complete street design and the potential for on-street protected bike lanes.
- An **economic analysis** to provide an understanding of the economic environment and issues faced by retailers along the Danforth.
- A **planning study** to identify future city-building opportunities, guide new development, and enhance the public realm and quality of place.

The study is a joint initiative between three City divisions – Transportation Services, City Planning, and Economic Development and Culture.

Community Meeting

This is the first of a series of meetings for the Danforth Study process. The meeting will begin with an open house and a brief presentation about the study, including a review of the draft Terms of Reference followed by interactive group discussion. Comments from the community will help to shape the scope of this study.

Study Areas

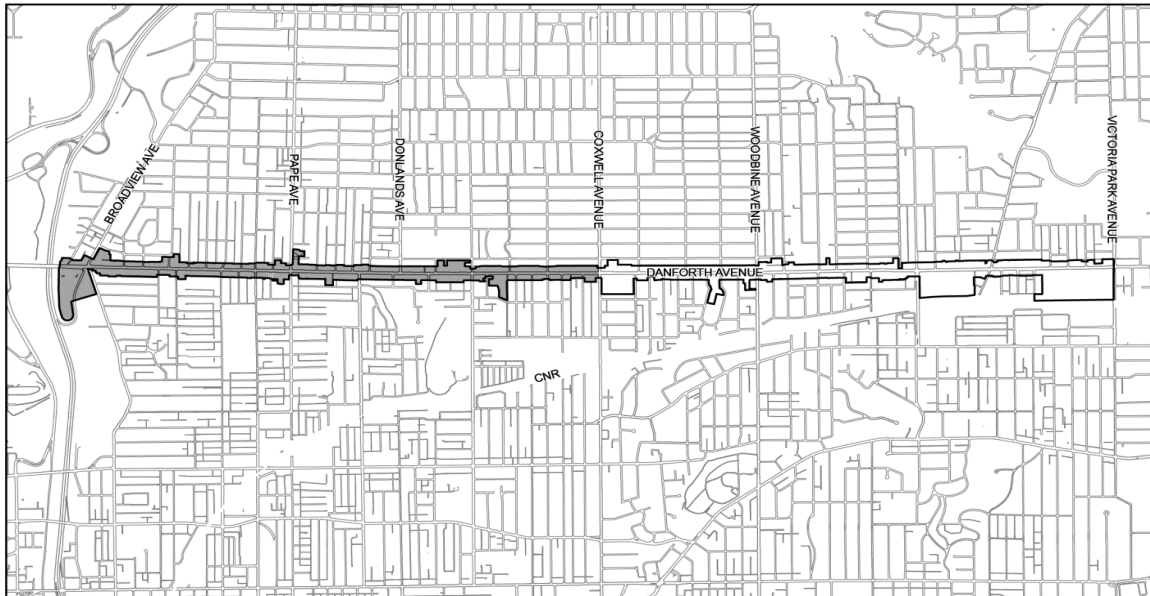
The **complete street and economic analysis** will be undertaken for the 6 km of Danforth Avenue between the Don Valley and Victoria Park Avenue (Study Area B).

The **planning study** will be undertaken between the Don Valley and Coxwell Avenue (Study Area A). Similar planning work has already been completed in the area from Coxwell Avenue to Victoria Park Avenue.
